Applications are invited for Physiotherapy Internship against 25 seats for 6 months in the Department of Orthopaedics, Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh with following terms & conditions:-

- i) Candidates should have passed Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) Course. Copy of Certificates/Detail Mark sheets to be attached.
- ii) The College/University from where the candidate has passed BPT Course should be recognized and should be affiliated with Indian Association of Physiotherapist (IAP). Copy of certificate to be attached.
- iii) No Objection Certificate (NOC) & Character Certificate for doing internship from parent institute.
- iv) Candidates who have done BPT through correspondence course will not be considered for internship in this institution.
- v) Candidates would be selected on merit as per their percentage of marks obtained in the final examination.
- vi) The fee will be charged for the above said training is Rs. 16,500/- as Training Fee alongwith amalgamated funds of Rs. 2,400/- and Rs. 1,000/- as security (refundable).

Interested candidates must apply by 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2010 (up to 4.00 p.m.) on given proforma alongwith Demand Draft of Rs. 200/- in favour of Director Principal, GMCH, Chandigarh payable at Chandigarh. Application not on given proforma will not be considered. Application form and other details may be downloaded from our website i.e. gmch.gov.in. The list of the selected candidates will be displayed on 22<sup>nd</sup> December, 2010 after 2.00 p.m. on GMCH Notice Boards and the batch will start from 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2011.

Earlier application if any, submitted by the candidate/applicant prior to issuance of this notice will not be considered for the above said Internship Training.
