3. TENURE OF THE POST

The above said posts are tenure posts and the appointments will be made initially for a period of one year from the date of joining, which shall be subject to annual review but may be extended on yearly basis after satisfactory performance of their duties, upto a maximum period of three years being a tenure post with no further extension under any circumstances. Senior Residency, if done, in any Central Institution/Hospital under the Central Residency Scheme, by any applicant, the same shall be counted while working out the tenure of three years so as the maximum period of Senior Residency does not exceed three years. The post of Spine fellow is a tenure post and the appointment will be made initially for a period of six months from the date of joining, which shall be subject to annual review but may be extended on yearly basis after satisfactory performance of their duties, upto a maximum period of three years being a tenure post with no further extension under any circumstances.

4. UPPER AGE LIMIT AS ON 01.01.2009

a) **FOR SENIOR RESIDENTS, CASUALTY MEDICAL OFFICERS (GEN. MEDICINE & GEN. SURGERY), RESIDENT ANAETHETIST, RESIDENT PATHOLOGIST & SPINE FELLOW (ORTHOAEDICS):**

33 years and in case of post doctoral degree holders is 35 years [Relaxable 3 years for OBC, 5 years for SC/ST & Govt. Servants (THROUGH PROPER CHANNEL). In case of widows, divorced

women and women judicially separated from their husbands, who are not remarried, shall be 35 years (40 years for members of SC).

- (b) **FOR DEMONSTRATORS, EMERGENCY MEDICAL OFFICERS, LADY MEDICAL OFFICERS.**
30 years for MBBS and 33 years for PG degree holders) [Relaxable 3 years for OBC, 5 years for SC/ST & Govt. Servants, through proper channel. In case of widows, divorced women and women judicially separated from their husbands, who are not remarried shall be 35 years (40 years for members of SC).

5. RESERVATION AND RELAXATION:

- (I) The reservation and relaxation in the upper age limit will be made only for the category of the posts reserved for such categories, as per the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- (II) The SC/OBC candidates applying against un-reserved posts are not entitled to any relaxation in upper age limit.
- (III) The claim of the candidate to SC/OBC (not BC) categories should be considered only when accompanied by the certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format.

6. PAY SCALE :

a) FOR SENIOR RESIDENTS, CASUALTY MEDICAL OFFICERS (GEN. SURGERY & GEN MEDICINE), RESIDENT ANAESTHETIST, RESIDENT PATHOLOGIST & SPINE FELLOW(ORTHOPAEDICS):

Rs. 10940/- p.m. in the first year, Rs. 11295/- p.m. in the second year & Rs.11650/-p.m. in the third year of the residency, which is inclusive of NPA. The emoluments in respect of PostGraduate Diploma holders will be reduced by Rs. 325/-.

b) FOR DEMONSTRATORS :

Pay scale: Rs.7220-11660 + NPA (for Medical Graduates only, if admissible).

c) FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL OFFICERS, LADY MEDICAL OFFICERS :

Pay scale: Rs. 7880-13500/- with initial start of Rs.8000/- + NPA if admissible.

8. Written Test

The decision regarding conduction of written test for the above said posts for short listing the candidates will be taken on receipt of number of applications and the public notice in this regard will be issued in the leading news papers separately.

9. OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- (I) The number of posts are tentative and may be increased or decreased.
- (II) The candidates belonging to their own category only will be considered against the aforesaid vacancies.
- (III) The Candidates already in Government service must route their applications **through proper channel** and also attach NOC from the present employer, failing which their applications shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- (IV) The persons who have earlier worked in this institute and their services were dispensed with on account of misconduct or otherwise by this institute are not eligible to apply against these posts.
